Requirements for transfer credit: Red River College students completing the Full-time two-year Business Administration Diploma with an overall 'B' average (3.0 GPA) may be eligible to receive transfer credit towards a University of Winnipeg Undergraduate Degree. A minimum grade of 'C+' is required for all transferrable RRC courses. Transfer credits would receive grades of 'S' for Standing. The specific grade earned does not transfer. There will be no retroactive transcript assessments processed after the application process has started; this will also apply to students previously assessed. Students must meet both Residency and Degree Requirements to graduate from the University of Winnipeg.
